- PLAY WITH POSTIVITY SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGE ESPECIALLY AFTER SETBACKS
- LISTEN TO YOUR COACHES; ACCEPT FEEDBACK, TRY TO ACT ON IT
- MISTAKES ARE PART OF LEARNING; YOU AND OTHERS WILL MAKE PLENTY OF THEM

- UPHOLD THE CLUB VALUES OF INTERGITY, RESPECT AND INCLUSION
- BE PROUD TO BE PART OF MUSSELBURGH RFC, REPRESENT THE BADGE, BE A ROLE MODEL
